**Arnold, R. K.**, is presently the head of the Executive Secretariat of the Telecom Regulatory Authority of India (TRAI), which deals with Telecom Regulations which inter alia includes Unified Licensing, Spectrum Management, Telecom Tariff, Interconnections, Quality of Service (QoS), Rural Telecommunications, Next Generation Networks (NGN), Direct to Home (DTH) and Cable Television, etc. TRAI is now perceived as one of the progressive regulators globally and is considered a role model by other regulators in the telecom sector.

As a member of the Indian Telecommunications Service (ITS) during the last 34 years, he gained the experience of working in one of the largest telecom networks in a developing country with the firsthand opportunity to handle problems of underdevelopment. He also had the privilege of interacting with various International agencies/organizations, participating in various International conferences

He has rich experience working in the field of telecommunications covering the areas of Telecom Development, Operations, Quality Assurance, Human Resource Development, Acceptance Testing and Evaluation of Telecom Products and Networks in addition to Telecom Regulation.
