Gonsalves, Timothy, PhD, is a founding member of TeNeT at the Department of Electrical Engineering, the Indian Institute of Management, Madras (IIT-Madras) He received a bachelor's degree in technology (1976) from IIT-Madras, a master's degree (1979) from Rice University, Houston, TX, and a PhD (1986) from Stanford University, CA, all in electrical engineering. His doctoral thesis dealt with the use of LANs for voice and data traffic. After receiving his doctorate, he joined the Computer Science Department, WPI, Worcester, MA, as an Assistant Professor. Since 1989, he has been with the Department of Computer Science and Engineering, IIT-Madras, India, where he is currently a Professor and the Head of the Department. His research interests include: design and implementation of integrated computer and telecom networking systems, network management systems, financial information systems and distributed, web-based software for rural applications. The main focus of his work is the development of technology and other infrastructure needed for the widespread use of the Internet, and fostering many software development activities in and for rural India.
