Kelly, Tim, PhD, is the Lead ICT Policy Specialist at the World Bank in Washington. He was formerly Head of the Strategy and Policy Unit of the International Telecommunication Union (ITU). Before joining ITU, he spent five years as a Communications Policy Analyst with the Organization for Economic Co-operation and Development (OECD) and three years with Logica Consultancy Ltd. Over the last twenty years, Kelly has specialized in the economics of the telecommunications industry. He has written or co-authored more than thirty books on the subject, including the ITU's "Internet Reports" and "World Telecommunication Development Reports" and "World Information Society Reports". He was in charge of the "content team" for the World Summit on the Information Society (WSIS), which concluded in November 2005.
