McGurk, Stephen, PhD, is a development economist who has spent more than two decades studying China, Southeast Asia, and South Asia. As Regional Director for South Asia and China for IDRC, he leads an active program of research in a diverse region. Projects have ranged from helping Afghanistan rebuild its health and agriculture sectors, to supporting India's rollout of mobile communication technology and the Internet to 600,000 villages. Before joining IDRC, McGurk was the program officer for the Ford Foundation's economic security program in China. He also worked for eight years as a consultant and economist for the World Bank.
