Before moving to India, Toyama spent seven years in MSR Redmond, Washington, USA, and in Cambridge, UK, working on computer vision, multimedia and geographic information systems. During the autumn of 2002, he took personal leave from Microsoft to teach mathematics at Ashesi University in Ghana. Toyama graduated from Yale with a PhD in Computer Science and from Harvard with a bachelor's degree in physics.
