Weinstein, Stuart A., PhD, is the Assistant Director of the Pacific Tsunami Warning Center (PTWC) and has been a staff Geophysicist at PTWC since 1998. He received bachelor degrees in geology and geophysics from Binghamton University in 1983, a master's degree in geological sciences from Northwestern University in 1986 and his PhD. from The Johns Hopkins University in 1991. Weinstein was an NSF Postdoctoral fellow in Earth Sciences at the University of Michigan (1991-93), and seeking better climate, was the SOEST Young Investigator at the University of Hawaii (1993-95). His main area of research during this time was the physics of planetary interiors. Today, he is focused more on developing and implementing methods for rapid earthquake source characterization. He's not really a seismologist (Geodynamicist actually), but does occasionally play one on TV.
