Xue, Lan, PhD, is a Professor and Dean of the School of Public Policy and Management at Tsinghua University, China. His teaching and research interests include science and technology, innovation policy and crisis management. Xue has a PhD in engineering and public policy from Carnegie Mellon University and taught at the George Washington University before returning back to China in 1996. He has served as a consultant to the World Bank, APEC and other international organizations, and acted as a policy adviser for many Chinese government agencies. He currently serves as a Vice President of the China Association of Public Administration, Vice President of the Chinese Association of Science and Technology Policy, and Vice Chairman of the National Steering Committee for MPA Education. He is also a member of the Visiting Committee for Harvard Kennedy School, a member of the international advisory board for UNU-MERIT, Vice Chair of the Global Agenda Council on Catastrophic Risks of the World Economic Forum (WEF) and a member of the Board of Governors of the International Development Research Center (IDRC).
