Network, network, network!


- Get to know people and how they influence policy process





Summary of Recommendations:

LIRNEasia has five (5) major recommendations:

- ISP performance metrics. Identify two sets of internet performance metrics: for fixed (wired and wireless) and for mobile broadband service; for compliance (download and upload speeds, latency) and for monitoring (data volume, packet loss, jitter).
- Testing methodology. NTC to measure performance metrics during:
 - a. multiple times of the day (to account for peak and off-peak times);
 - multiple days of the week (to account for changes in data traffic during week days and weekends);
 - in multiple domains (at least two domains local [a server located within the ISP network] and International [a server located at the first U.S. Point-of-Presence]);
 - d. in multiple locations in the Philippines (to account for service areas of varying levels of congestion), both known and unknown to ISPs; and
 - e. on a quarterly basis, in the least.
- Typical speed. Require Internet service providers (ISPs) to measure and publish typical
 or average download speeds per location (e.g., city level) using an NTC-approved
 measurement tool.
- Roles and responsibility. NTC to independently measure ISP performance and officially analyze and publish results, but software or web-based tool to be made available to the public.
- Publication. NTC to publish results two weeks after the quarterly tests are completed.
