Sarvodaya in partnership with LIRNEasia is organizing a planning meeting to discuss the “Real-Time Biosurveillance Program Research Project” (RTBP) with Healthcare Workers participating in the project. The aim of the RTBP research is to mobilize Healthcare Workers in the rural settings with mobile phones to record and submit health-related information for the purpose of consolidating case data for detecting disease outbreaks before they reach epidemic states. Problem that the RTBP promises to solve is to strengthen existing disease surveillance and detection communication systems, reduce latencies in detecting and communicating disease information, and set a stand interoperability protocol for sharing disease information with national and international health-related organizations in the region. The research will implement an ICT system and evaluate the RTBP over one year. A major part of this initial meeting, to be held on 07-October-2008, is to bring together the Sarvodaya Community Healthcare Workers and Domain Experts to discuss the project scope.
